CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All teams have submitted a team sheet and have paid the registration fee
- All players are registered in the right age group (we are following this seasons age groups)
- QR code sign in by your pitch or at CCSS coordinators table
- All teams have to wear the same colour jersey (bibs available for clashes)
- Shin pads and appropriate foot wear to be worn

Pitch sizes: 30m wide x 40m long (U6 20m x 30m. Managers permitted on the field for U6)

Pitches : Far left looking out from the car park - pitch 1 (6s), pitch 2 in the middle (Deploy), far right pitch 3 (Flip out)

Goal size : 2m x 3m

GK Area : 5m x 3m (approx) marked with rubber disc markers

Toilets: Will be open

RULES & GUIDELINES

- Minimum of 4 teams per group
- The schedule will be played over 8 weeks
Week 1-6 Group games (play everyone twice)
Week 7: Playoffs: 1 v 4, 2 v 3
Week 8: Finals, winners of both games play as does losers
- The manager must fill out the team sheets before they play. Stating date of birth and this seasons age group they played under
- Players will be eligible to play in the same age group as the current season. E.g U11s club football season this year is U11 forpowerleague
- Teams must arrive 10 minutes before your game. The manager must notify the organiser of your arrival. Do not enter the court until it is your game
- Teams consist of 5 players including a GK. Maximum of 3 subs
- Games will be 2 x 12-minute halves with a two minute halftime break. Air horn will sound
- 3 points will be allocated for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss
- Red and yellow cards can be issued. Red card means they will leave the field and miss the next game. 3 yellows means one game suspension
- Subs are unlimited throughout the games but the subs are to be made in-game (entering from the middle of the court) as it will not stop for subs. Maximum of 2 GK changes are per mitted per half
- Subs must enter the court at the halfway line
- Free-kicks and corners are normal but throw-ins are kick ins. You cannot directly score from kick ins.
- Free kicks are direct and walls need to be 5m back
- There are no offsides

RULES & GUIDELINES

- When the GK catches the ball, they can drop kick, roll out or throw the ball to distribute.
- When the ball goes out of play for a goal kick, it must be taken from the floor
- Players must move back 10 meters away from opposite goal during a goal kick
- Mercy rule: If your team goes 6 goals behind, you can field one extra player for the remainder of that game (at the opposition coaches discretion)
- Ensure that teams are at the PLC at least 5 minutes before their game is scheduled to start. Failure to arrive on time may result in goal deductions or in extreme cases a forfeit
- Each team will need an allocated manager to organise subs during the game, entering at the half way mark
- Games will start and end with a universal buzzer. The ref will decide whether to let a free kick or corner to take place after the horn has blown
- The timer will not stop in the case of an injury and we encourage the coach to sub the injured player during the game. The timer will only stop if the injury is deemed serious enough to warrant immediate medical attention
- In finals games, if the score is tied at the end of the game there will be a penalty shootout to determine the winner
- There will be no refunds for teams not showing up
- Partial refunds will be offered if the comp cannot be completed

COMPETITION ETIQUETTE
